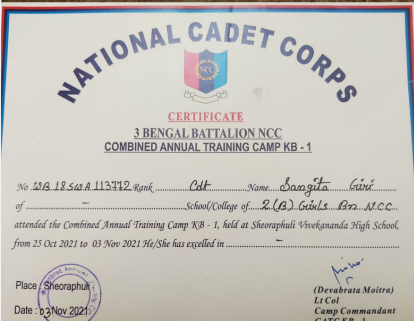


<b>Event Name :</b> Combined Annual Trainging Camp KB1

<b>Objective:</b> The basic aims of camps is to introduce cadets to a regimented way of life and helps in developing team work, leadership qualities, self-confidence, self-reliance and dignity of labor in cadets. Cadets are exposed to excitement of camp life where they apply the theoretical knowledge they had gained in institutional training.	
<b>Brief Description:</b> The classes are conducted as per given syllabus where certain aspects of NCC training are taught once again. In this camp, cadets must be awake at 5am and be on the line at 6am where attendance will be taken and physical training will be done for one hour, then breakfast will be served where cadets are also given the task of serving food to follow cadets. Usually a break of an hour or two will be given to cadets between each activity such as firing of .22 caliber rifle, tent pitching, interactive class displays and cultural programs are also observed. The camps helps the cadets adjust to a regimented way of life, it also teaches the cadets to live a healthy lifestyle and be active in day to day life.	



## Outcome:

The camps acts as a refresher training for cadets and they are also trained in basic skills of survival and emergencies besides other topics. Another activity in camp is the “dogwatch” where in two cadets are to stay up on sentry duty for two hours at any given time of the day. Those caught sleeping, especially during late night and early morning shift or missing from duty are severely reprimanded or penalized. This helps the cadets to become more alert, observant and vigilant at all times. Camps also teaches the cadets to be responsible and accountable. Camps are not only fun and excitement but also teaches the cadets many things, provide knowledge and vast experiences of military life. Camps also help the cadets in building Comradeship. It helps cadets to open up and be bold and confident.
