REPORT OF CONTINUOUS INTERNAL ASSESSMENT, DOUBT CLEARANCE CLASSES & REMEDIAL CLASSES

With the objective of developing writing skills after the long phase of lockdown and online examination process, Continuous Internal Examinations were conducted for all students of Sem 6, 4 and 2 every week by each teacher of the department. The exams were conducted by the department internally during class hours. The answer scripts were shown to the students after evaluation in a doubt clearance class. The grievances (if any) and doubts were addressed in these classes. The students who scored less than 40% were marked as Slow Learners. Special Remedial classes were arranged for them, study materials were also provided by the teachers and they were instructed to write the answers once again in a separate class test. If any student remained absent for most of the exams then the teachers arranged a parent-teacher meeting only for those students. The cause of absence or very poor performance of the students was reported to the parents and ways of improvement were suggested if required.

OUTCOME

- 1. The CIE prepared the students for the offline final exams. After the long phase of online exams, the habit of writing in an exam was beneficial. They gained confidence and were brought back to the habit of writing and studying hard.
- 2. The students were given a scope to correct their errors and work harder before the final exams.
- 3. The doubts and problems of the students were brought to the notice of the teachers in doubt clearing sessions.
- 4. Solutions were offered to the students for their improvement.
- 5. The students were already revised with the syllabus before the final exams. Continuous revisions enabled them to perform better.
- 6. The remedial classes provided extra support to the slow learners.
