11th December, 2024

Gita Jayanti is an annual celebration to commemorate the day when Lord Krishna rendered his philosophical teachings to prince Arjuna on the first day of the 18-day battle of Kurukshetra. The festival celebrates the arrival of the sacred Hindu scripture, Bhagavad Gita from Shri Krishna, an avatar of Maha Vishnu. It is observed every year on the Shukla Ekadashi falling on the Margashirsha month of the Hindu calendar. On this day, devotees keep a day-long fast and observe the Vaikuntha Ekadashi Vrata.



Gita Jayanti has been celebrated in the department of Sanskrit on 11th December, 2024 at 10:45 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. During this session students of this department has chanted few slokas from Srimadbhagavadgita and Professors also has given their lectures on the value of the Gita in the social life.
