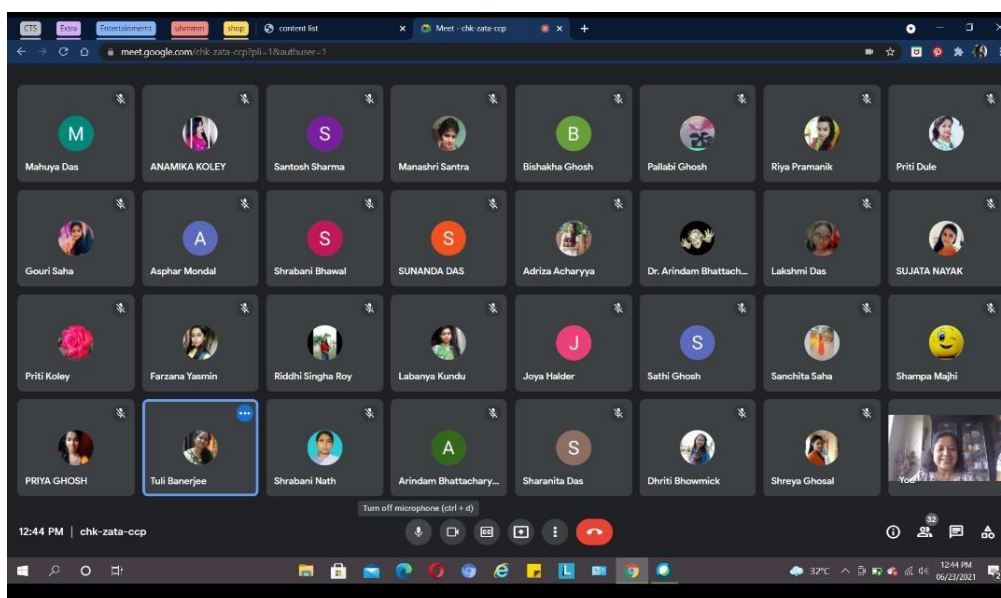

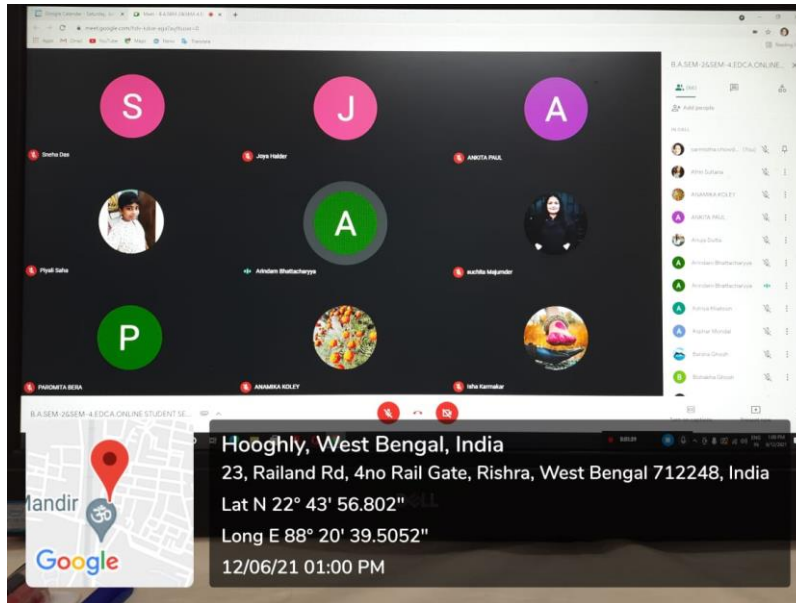

About the Webinar

Technology has been playing a key role of our education system, especially during pandemic situation. Now education technology should be used as a way to improve the techno pedagogical skill of teachers & learners and prepare them for the knowledge society. So there is a great need of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) integration in the entire education system. The responsibility also lies upon the teaching community to implement ICT in teaching – learning situation. Advance technology is always considered important determinants of the civilisation and a principal driver of educational, economical and societal change. But excessive use of technology mediated teaching-learning process instead of classroom teaching due to nationwide lockdown to fight against the Covid 19 pandemic creates digital divide and discriminates among the learners coming from different socio-economic strata. It appears as a constraint against the motto of 'Education for All'. Bridge of communication among all learners cannot be built due to unavailability of ICT tools and net connectivity. Now the teaching communities are facing a new challenge of digital divide. Therefore, the present education system is expected to function for acquisition of knowledge through modern technology and also to work for bridging the digital divide.

The webinar is aimed to explore the prospects of 'Technology Mediated Learning' (TML) as well as problems of TML at present context. How the learners learn and the teachers should teach through technology and the improvement of the use of new technology to overcome the challenge of digital divide will be discussed in the 'One Day International Webinar'. Hope that this Webinar will prove to be useful for all and so the way to make teaching-learning process more fruitful and effective maintaining the objective of equality & quality in the sphere of higher education.

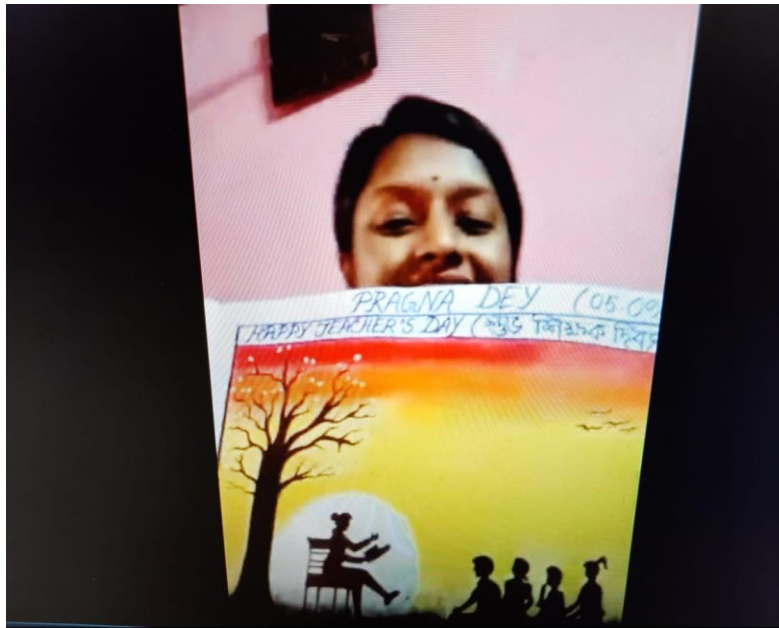


Fig. 8: Notice for Teacher's Day Celebration

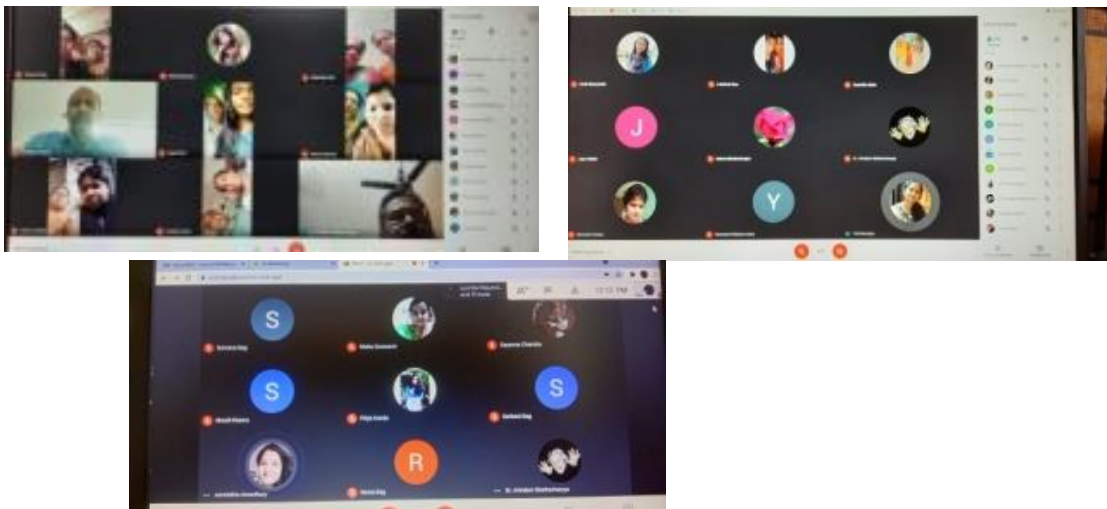
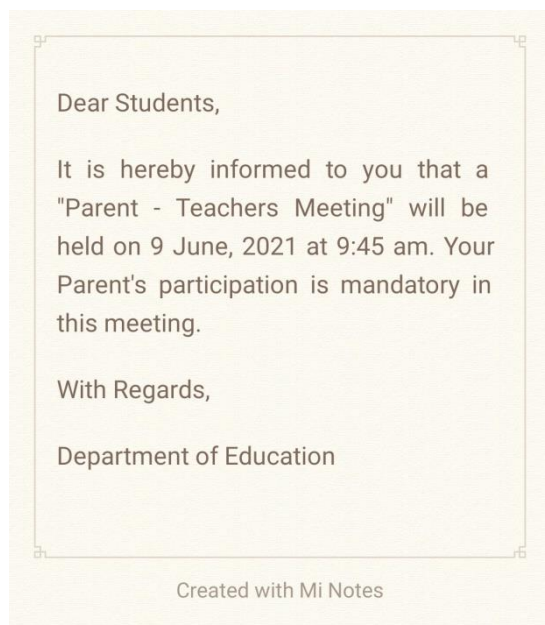


Fig. 9: Notice for Parent-Teachers' meetings (online)
