Mentor – Mentee Report from Department of Sociology, Serampore Girls' College

The student mentoring system is introduced in the Department of Sociology, Serampore Girls' College. Departmental teachers (3) are involved in the process of mentoring. Every mentor is allotted 60-65 students to take care of them. The mentor has a chalked-out responsibility to take care of all the mentees such as to provide them personal counselling, to support them for any kind of difficulty in their curriculum, to make provision of remedial class for them and to always support them as and when required.

The mentor also works for finding out hidden talent of the students in various aspects of academic, co-curricular, extra-curricular and extra mural activities so that they can be promoted to do various activities in the concerned area for their holistic development. The mentor also contacts and meets the parents of

his or her mentees to discuss their progress or any other matter, as and when required.

- This pandemic situation created financial problems in the homes of many students. As a result, initially many could not attend online classes. Mentors talked to them personally and found out they were in a lot of trouble in day-to-day life. Mentors have kept in touch with them and kept in touch with their education system through counselling and motivation. In some critical cases mentors have helped the students with internet data recharge so that they could attend online classes. As a result, the number of dropouts among students in much lower.
- During this academic session a student, named Aditi Nandi (Student of fourth semester), who has a hearing as well as speech problem, was specially assisted through mentoring and counselling. The mentor was in constant touch with her father to ensure that she got assistance at home to attend the on-line classes.
- In another case, a student named Subhashree Dey (Student of sixth semester), was found to be missing from on-line classes. On enquiry by mentor it got revealed that she had got married and education had taken a back seat. With active mentoring and coordination with the student, her husband and parents the student could be brought back to attend on-line classes
- In a different case a student named Chandrima Chakraborty (Student of sixth semester), was found getting diverted from studies due to bad influence. Timely counselling by mentor brought her back to right track.
