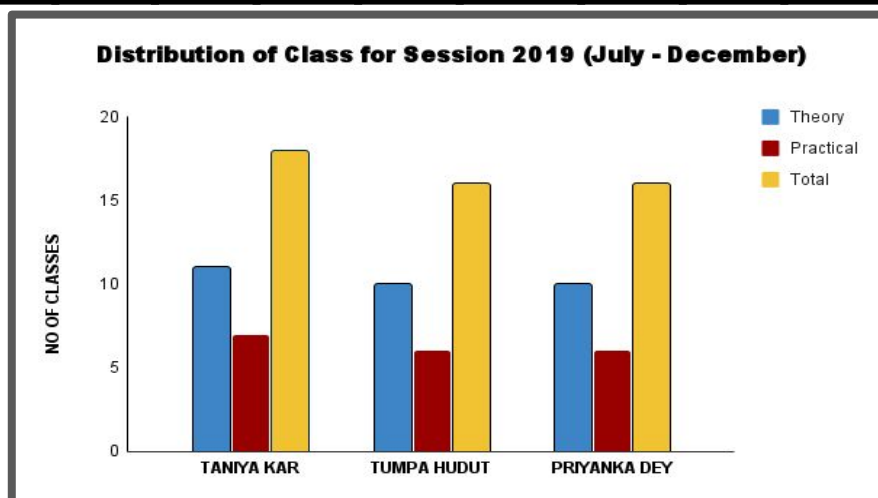

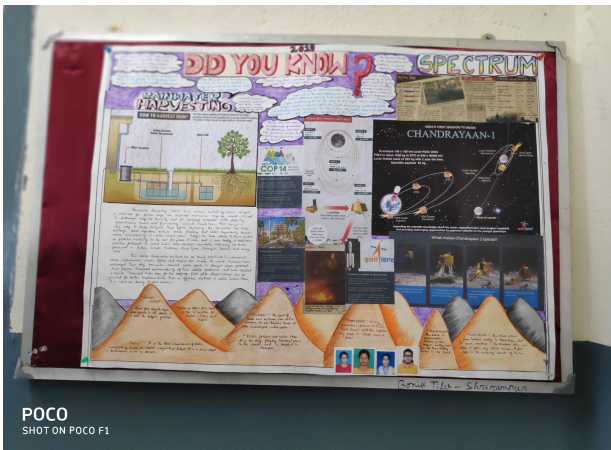


## 5 .DEPARTMENTAL MAGAZINE

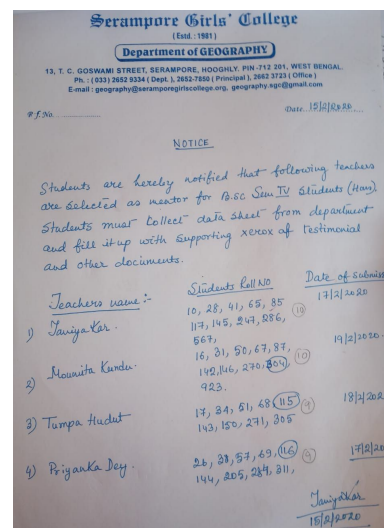
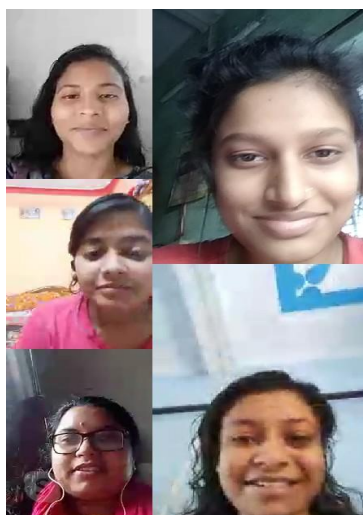

# TEACHER'S DAY CELEBRATION

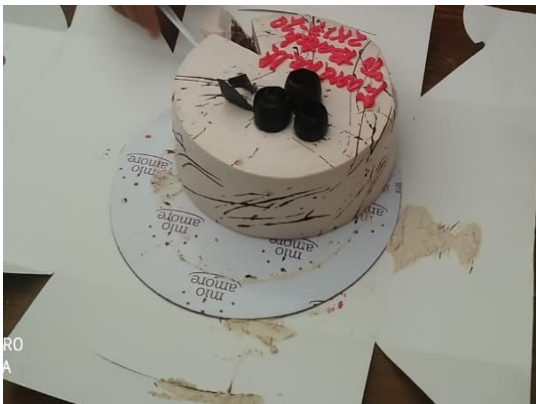

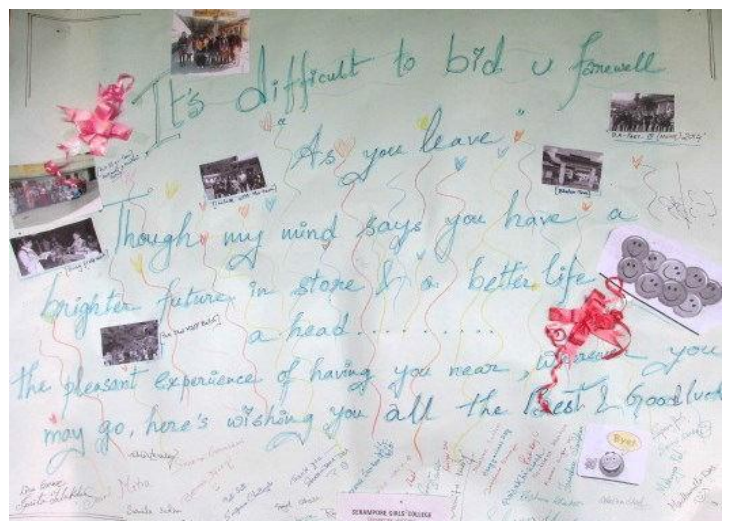
