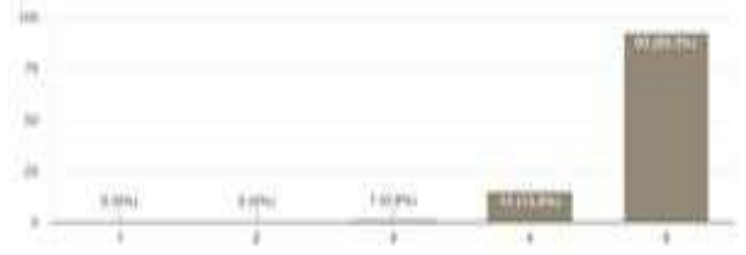

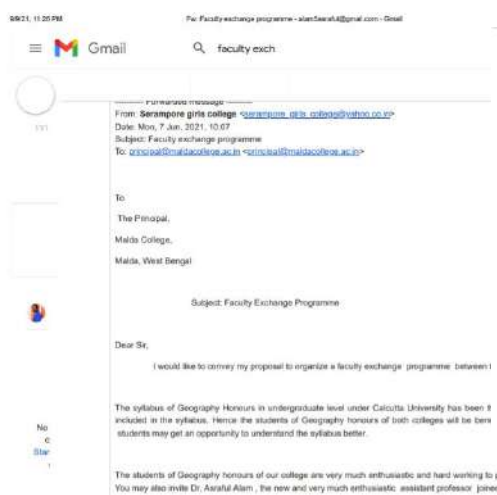


5. FACULTY EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

TEACHER'S DAY CELEBRATION

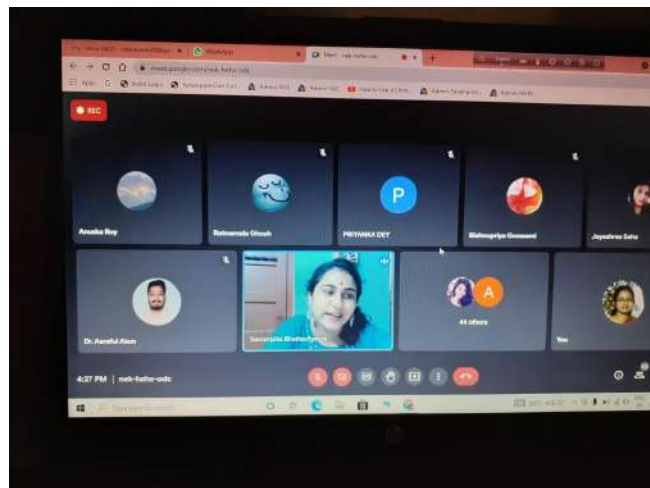
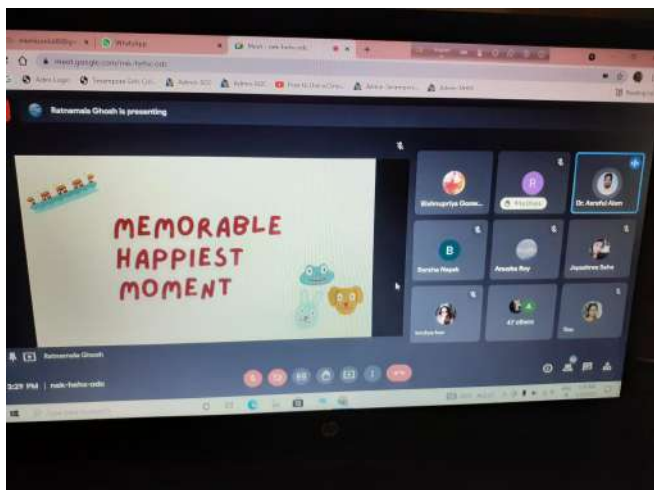
