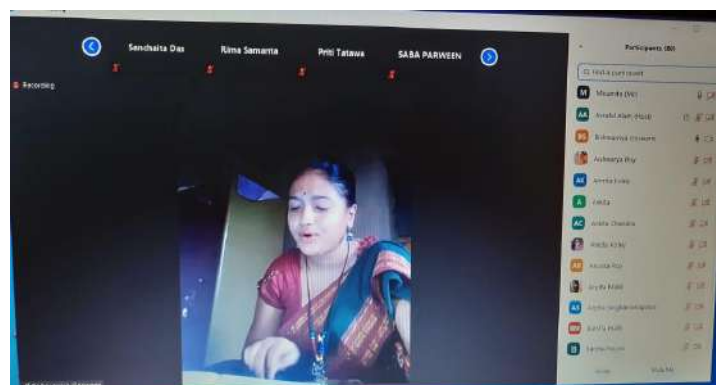


TEACHER'S DAY CELEBRATION

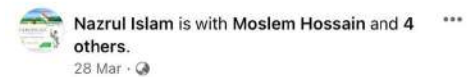

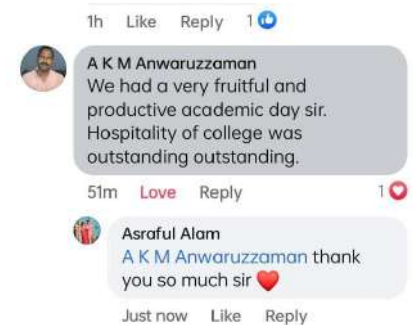
howranj), and many more joined the seminar.




