NSS Report 2021-2022 Unit I & Unit II The National Service Scheme was started by Government of India, Ministry of Education and Culture, Govt. of India, in Collaboration with State Government in the year 1969 in 37 selected Universities. Calcutta University has been participating in the scheme right from its inception. At present the scheme is run by the ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports in Central Government and Department of Higher & Technical Education in State Government. The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a Central Sector Scheme of Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports. It provides opportunity to the student youth of Graduate at college level of India to take part in various government led community service activities & programmes. The sole aim of the NSS is to provide hands on experience to young students in delivering community service. Our NSS unit is functioning from 1981. It is extending its activities in the society regularly and continuously since its inception. Now the strength of our two units are 200 students.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- 2. Understand themselves in relation to their community.
- 3. Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem solving process.
- 4. Develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility.

- 7. Gain skills in mobilizing community participation.
- 8. Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitude.
- 9. Develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters
- 10.Practice national integration and social harmony.


