At present the scheme is run by the ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports in Central Government and Department of Higher & Technical Education in State Government. The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a Central Sector Scheme of Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports. It provides opportunity to the student youth of Graduate at college level of India to take part in various government led community service activities & programmes. The sole aim of the NSS is to provide hands on experience to young students in delivering community service. Our NSS unit is functioning from 1981. It is extending its activities in the society regularly and continuously since its inception. Now the strength of our two units are 200 students.

27th June 2024 – Celebrate International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking


