Some Views of the Philosophers / Thinkers about Idealism:

- According to Plato, “Ideas are of the ultimate cosmic significance. They are rather the essence or archetypes which give form to cosmos. These ideas are eternal and unchanging.”
- According to Horne, “Idealism holds that the order of the World is due to the manifestation in space and time of an eternal and spiritual reality.”
- According to Ross, “Goodness, truth and beauty are seen to be absolutes each existing in its own right and entirely desirable in reality.”
- According to Rusk, “Morality and religion are peculiar to man and differentiate him from animals.”

Key Concept of Philosophy & Education

Idealism is a part of the (Syllabus of) Western Philosophy;

What is Philosophy? : Meaning in English: ‘Philo’ (Love) + ‘Sophia’ (Wisdom, Truth); Meaning of Philosophy: Love of Wisdom / Search for Truth; Indian Word ‘Darshana’ comes from ‘Drish Dhatu’; Meaning of it: ‘Dekha’ (To See) => Self-realization for liberation, Realization of Soul; [D. Sastra is called as Moksa-Sastra’]

What is Education?: Education comes from ‘Latin Words’ i.e. ‘educere’ (to lead out), ‘educare’ (to bring up), ‘educatum’ (the act of training);

Meaning of Education: Both in ‘Narrow’ & ‘Wider’;

Wider Meaning of Education: From the broad point of view, all life thoughtfully lived is education (W.H.Kilpatrick);

Education is a Multi-disciplinary & Inter-disciplinary Subject, where Philosophy gives the right direction towards truth.

Actually Philosophy determines the theoretical aim of Education and Education is the dynamic aspect of Philosophy.

Relation Between Philosophy and Education

There is a Very Close Relation between Philosophy & Education. The Bramhmanic, Buddhist, Islamic Education were influenced by Vedantaic, Buddhist & Islamic Philosophy respectively.

- **Sir Percy Nun said: “Every Scheme of education being at bottom a practical philosophy touches lift at every point.”**
- **James Ross said: “Philosophy and Education are two sides of the same coin, the former is contemplative while latter is the active side.”**
- **John Dewey said: “Philosophy may even be defined as the general theory of education.”**
- **Gentile Told: “Education without Philosophy would mean a failure to understand the precise nature of Education.”**
- **Let us see the influence of ‘Idealism’ in the field of ‘Education’-**

i. IDEALISM AND AIM OF EDUCATION:

According to **Vivekananda**, "Education is the manifestation of perfection already in man."

- Self-realization (to know thyself);
- Universal Education;
- Development of Intellectuality & Personality;
- Healthy Mind in Healthy Body;
- Development of Morality, Spirituality and Creativity;
- Conservation, Promotion & Transmission of Cultural Heritage;
- Achieve the Absolute Ideals;

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Forms of Idealism:

There are Various Forms of Idealism:

1. Subjective Idealism; (Barkley)
2. Absolute Idealism; (Fiktay, Hegel)
3. Objective Idealism; (Plato)
4. Phenomenal Idealism; (Kant)

CONCEPT of IDEALISM

- Idealism is an Old Philosophical Doctrine. "Idealistic Philosophy takes many and varied forms, but the postulate underlying all is that mind or sprit is the essential World stuff that the true reality is of a mental character" (J. S. Ross)
- Idea+ism = Idealism. Here the letter 'I' is inserted for euphony (Idealism is in reality idea-ism with the 'I' instead for euphony).
- Idealism recognizes human ideas, feelings, and ideals more important than natural and scientific phenomena.
- It emphasizes on the study of man and his mind. According to Plato, the prime aim of human is to achieve the 'Truth, Goodness and Beauty'.
- In Bengali, Idealism is called as 'VABBAD' or 'ADORSHOBAD'

Fundamental Principles of Idealism

- Idealists believe in two forms of whole world: Material World & Spiritual World;
- Idealists give more importance to spiritual world than material world;
- True reality is spiritual in nature;
- Human body is mortal and soul is immortal;
- Man is the part of an Absolute Power. Nothing exists, except what exists in absolute mind, of which our finite minds are parts;
- Knowledge and Values are pre-existing eternal and Universal (Truth, Beauty & Goodness);
- What Mind projects into the World is the only Reality.

[Idealism holds that ultimate reality is Spiritualism (D.M.Dutta)]

Limitations of Idealism:

- Abstract Doctrine;
- Avoids the Real Problems of Human Society;
- Increases the importance of intellectualism but not gives importance on others;
- Truth, Beauty & Goodness – These Values are not Absolute;
- Gives more importance to the teachers & less importance on learners;
- Gives emphasis on 'Rote Learning' than Activity;
- Gives greater importance on Humanities than Science & Technology;
- Give emphasis on 'Spiritual World' than 'Material World'

ii. IDEALISM AND CURRICULUM:

- **Intellectual Curriculum** - Language, Literature, History, Geography, Mathematics, Science;
- **Aesthetic Curriculum** - Music, Dancing, Painting, Writing of Essay & Poetry;
- **Moral Curriculum** - Theology, Ethics, Metaphysics;
- **Physical Education** - Health Education, Physiology, Games & Sports, Gymnastics etc.
