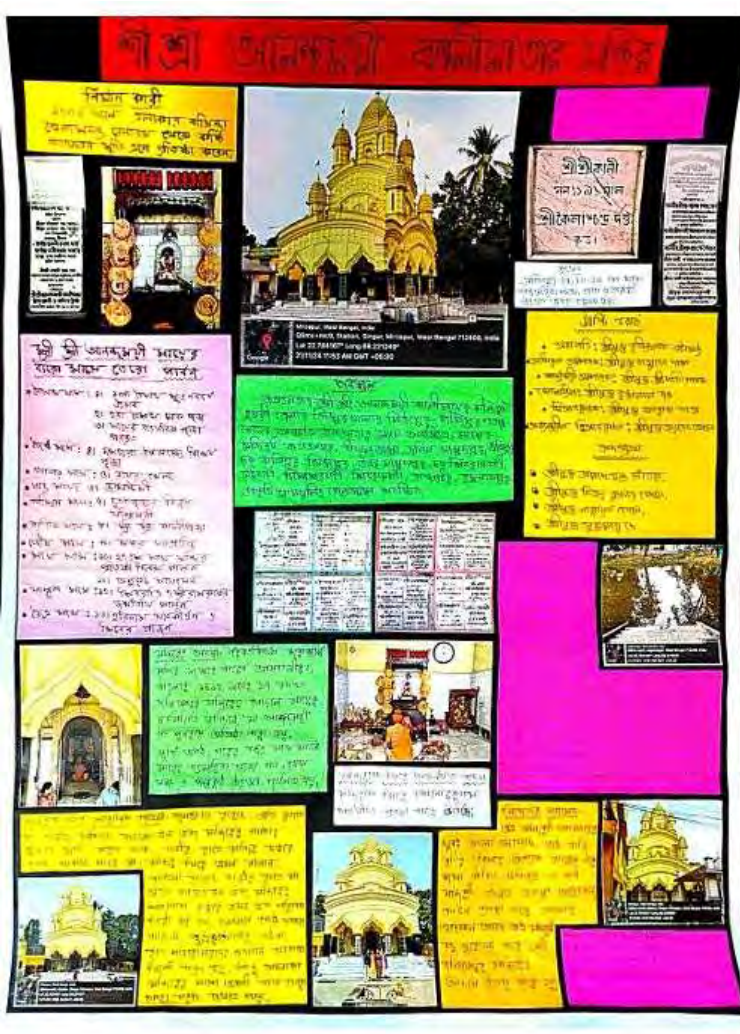

- To help them find out more research or job opportunities in various institutions and libraries.

**Description:**

Department of Sanskrit organized the Summer Internship Programme 2025 on Manuscript and Library Studies at Sanskrit Sahitya Parishat, Fariapukur, Shyam Bazar, Kolkata. 19 students got registered in this course conducted by Sanskrit Sahitya Parishat, Kolkata. Classes held in offline mode for 15 day or 60 hours. Three types of examinations have been arranged for those students – Viva-voce (28.05.2025), Practical (31.05.2025), and Theory / Project (01.05.2025). Prof. Nabanarayan Bandyopadhyay, former Director of the Department of Vedic Studies, R.B.U. had been invited by the Sanskrit Sahitya Parishat as an external examiner for students. The students have been awarded after the completion of the course by Dr. Ruma Bandyopadhyay, Secretary of Sanskrit Sahitya Parishat, Kolkata.

**Outcomes:**

- Students acquainted the process of preservation and cataloguing manuscripts and books too.
- It promoted research and publication of unpublished manuscripts.
- It enhanced student's interest and appreciation of India's manuscript heritage.
- It encouraged advance studies in manuscriptology and library Science.
- Even they can apply for the workshop or further advance courses on manuscriptology.
- This has helped students gain fundamental knowledge about library studies, which will benefit them in their careers.

Sub.: Proposal for summer internship.

Dear Madam,

As per notification No. CSR/29/2024 dated 04.06.2024 circulated by the Registrar of University of Calcutta the students of 2nd Semester are required to complete a summer internship course. Several options have been recommended for dealing with this internship course. Probably the following three options are suitable and useful for the students of Sanskrit (2nd Semester):

1. manuscriptology,
2. Preparing bibliography of books in Sanskrit,
3. Proof reading of books in Sanskrit.

After an adjuvant discussion with my colleagues we have decided that among these three alternatives a 15 days' workshop in manuscriptology should be the best option for them, as it may be much helpful in future for their further studies in Sanskrit.
