### Objective:

- Provide safe and quality blood and blood components collected from voluntary donors, round the clock, at affordable cost to the general public and free of cost to the poor.
- Ensure safety and quality of blood.
- Motivate and maintain a permanent well-indexed record of voluntary blood donors.
- Educating the community on the beneficial aspects of blood donation and harmful effect of collecting blood from paid donors.
- Actively encourage voluntary blood donation and gradually eliminate professional blood donors.
- Promote AIDS awareness and education to the general public.

### Brief Description:

**Voluntary blood donors** are the cornerstone of a safe and adequate supply of blood and blood products. The safest blood donors are voluntary, non-remunerated blood donors from low-risk populations. Despite this notion, family/replacement donors still provide more than 45% of the blood collected in India. Such donors are supposed to be associated with a significantly higher prevalence of transfusion-transmissible infections (TTIs) including HIV, hepatitis B, hepatitis C, syphilis and malaria.



**Outcome:**

Donating blood is very beneficial for the donor as well as the acceptor. It saves lives and helps people overcome their critical situation. The blood donor's body gets revitalized and generates new cells which freshen it up.
