Outcome:

General Rawat's death was confirmed by the Indian Air Force late on Wednesday. The helicopter crash had taken place shortly after noon. <u>CDS General Bipin Rawat and the others were on board an Indian Air Force Mi-17V5 helicopter</u>, which took off from the Sulur IAF base near Coimbatore. General Rawat was on his way to Defence Staff College in Wellington to attend an event.
