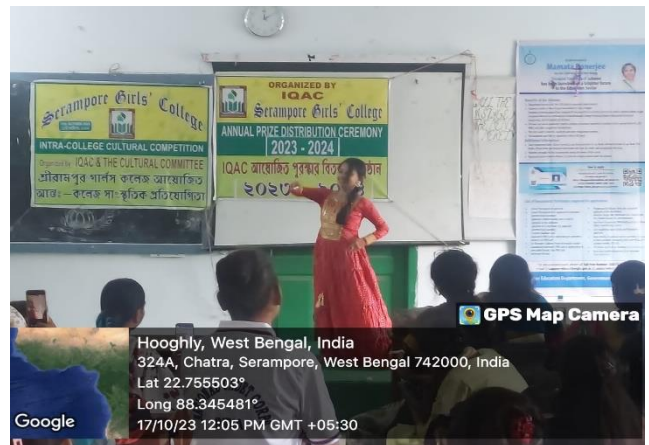


Events of cultural committee in the Academic Year

- **Worship of goddess Saraswati**—Students, teaching and non-teaching staff actively participate in offering devotion followed by Saraswati Puja bhog.

- **Outcome** - Students participated with a lot of enthusiasm and came out with flying colours.



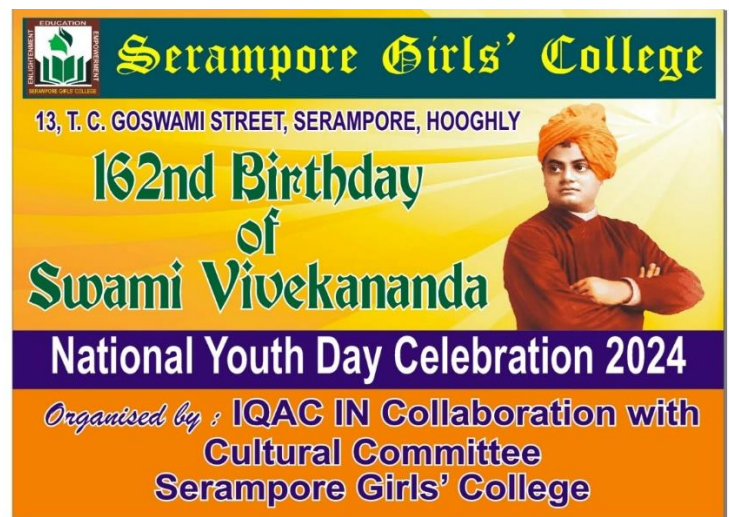
Report on Student's Week Celebration
